

## Oak Hollow Subdivision Meeting, 4-19-01, 10:00 am

### Old Business:

Treas. M. Potter reported all dues have been paid except ~~two~~ <sup>one</sup>.

Mz Ann brand and Mz Lisa Dangel were acknowledged and thanked for planting entrance area flowers.

M. Potter will remind Rudy that entrance area should be weeded as per our contract.

M. Potter has replaced the sprinkler box which may have been injured by school children. He also repaired and replaced sprinkler heads.

M. Bernardo mentioned he received a letter from Seminole Cnty outlining the do's and don'ts of planting in the right of way of the trail. I.e. no structures and no trees.

Mz. Lisa Dangel and others suggested planting trees on the perimeter of the catch basin after the rains resume. She also expressed concern over the danger of falling trees.

"The Proposal" ( made by the committee last spring ) for land scaping the pie shapped Commons Area will not be pursued at present because The St. John's Water Management Comm. Has requested that people do not plant trees or shrubs until the drought is over.

### New Business:

It was mentioned that one yard in the neighborhood could receive better maintenance.

It was also mentioned that the new houses on Kelly Gr. St. are being watered excessively. New lawns made be watered in excess of twice weekly only for the first 30 days. It was suggested that Mr Perry Reams ( the builder ) be contacted and if necessary call the Oviedo Water Dept.

M. Potter made a brief references to the budget and insurance and will present a more comprehensive statement at the next Bd of Dr. meeting.

It was suggested we poll the residents as to what time and day of the week would be convenient for them to attend a sub. Meeting. It would be appreciated if we could get more input from the members.

It was mentioned that Mr. P. Reams incurred a cost of \$500.00 for the removal of the trees, vines, shrubs and other yard waste when the pie shaped Commons Area was cut down last spring. This should be addressed to a satisfactory conclusion.
