- Coach lights on the brick wall at the front entrance need to be replaced. A follow up meeting necessary to discuss purchase.
- Neighborhood work day tentatively planned for Saturday, April 13th at 8am. We will be cutting back the wedges at the front entrance in order to help make routine maintenance easier.
- We discussed placing a sign in the Tot Lot to protect us against personal injury claims. It would say something like: "Enter at your own risk. Not responsible for loss, damage or injury." This will be discussed further when we reconvene for the tree estimates and coach light selection.

Jay spoke of removing the Tot Lot swing set and the jungle gym. Explained that is was unsafe and deteriorating due to weather and vandalism. All voted on removing the jungle gym and keeping the swing set and repairing it. Discussion of putting the jungle gym on Craig's List to get rid of it. Nancy Worth and David McCorquodale thought it would be a good idea of posting a sign at the entrance of the Tot Lot stating 'No Trespassing/Private Property unless an Oak Hollow residence'. Jay will call the city regarding the sign. All agreed. Further discussion of our HOA liability coverage on the Tot Lot is being investigated.
